## Peninsula Red, White, and Pink. A trio of blends from Door Peninsula Winery



Peninsula Red is a combination of our Door County cherry wine with two other red wine varieties. The cherry wine provides a lighter mouthfeel, with less tannin, and fruit forward aromas, a new direction for cherry wine from Door Peninsula Winery. This wine blend has aromas and flavors reminiscent of red berry, current, pepper and red cherry. A short period of oak aging provides a smooth and sweet tannin structure. A surprising wine that matches with Beef and BBQ, or strong cheeses.



Flavorful Peninsula Pink wine is a fun, fresh way to enjoy sun filled days on the Door Peninsula. A fantastic fruit forward blend of 2 grape wines with a splash of cherry. Vivid in color and slightly sweet, Peninsula Pink shows intense flavors and mouth feel. There are endless ways to enjoy this wine. Serve with lunch, appetizers, seafood, or Italian dishes.



Peninsula White is a refreshing, light bodied semi-sweet blend of Seyval Blanc and apple table wine. The French-American hybrid grape variety 'Seyval Blanc' is grown here in Door County and is the largest white grape variety planted east of the Rocky Mountains. Peninsula White has aromas of honey, fresh citrus, and floral notes, and flavors that are nicely balanced with sweet vanilla and apple. Ready to match with most light dinner foods, fruit or sharp cheeses.
